

Auto Insurance Fraud Prevention Checklist

Auto insurance fraud affects all drivers in Ontario by raising insurance premiums. We all have a role to play in combatting auto insurance fraud.

Learn how to prevent and report fraud with this checklist below.

How to prevent auto insurance fraud:

- When purchasing insurance, choose an insurance agent or company that is licensed with FSRA (visit fsrao.ca/auto-fraud-prevention to learn how)
- Never purchase auto insurance with cash or money transfers
- Don't be afraid to ask your insurance agent, broker or company questions to ensure the product is the right fit for you
- Look out for requests for cash-only transactions, strange email addresses or inconsistent documents
- Call the company listed on your policy to ensure it's valid

What to do if you suspect auto insurance fraud:

- If you suspect collision fraud, take photos of the accident scene
- Take notes and record as much information as you can
- Call your insurance company to report it
- Report the matter to police
