## **NOTICE OF INTENDED DECISION**

**I INTEND TO MAKE AN ORDER** under section 69 of the *PBA* that the **Pension Plan for the Hourly Employees of Quality Meat Packers Limited and Toronto Abattoirs Limited**, Registration Number **0985101** (the “Plan”) be wound up effective **April 30, 2014**.

**I INTEND TO MAKE THE ORDER FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS:**

**There was a cessation or suspension of employer contributions to the pension fund.**

**The employer failed to make contributions to the pension fund as required by the *PBA*.**

**The employer is bankrupt within the meaning of the Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act (Canada).**

**Such further and other reasons as may come to my attention.**

**YOU ARE ENTITLED TO A HEARING** by the Financial Services Tribunal (the “Tribunal”) pursuant to section 89(6) of the *PBA*. **To request a hearing, you must deliver to the Tribunal a written notice that you require a hearing, within thirty (30) days after this Notice of Intended Decision is served on you.**<sup>1</sup>
