**NOTICE OF INTENDED DECISION**

**I INTEND TO MAKE AN ORDER** under section 69 of the PBA that the Pension Plan for the Employees of Labelad Ltd., Registration 697987 (the “Plan”) be wound up effective July 18, 2012.

**I INTEND TO MAKE THE ORDER FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS:**

There was a cessation or suspension of employer contributions to the pension fund.

Failure of employer to make contributions to the pension fund as required by the Act or the Regulations.

A significant number of members have ceased to be employed by the employer as a result of the discontinuance or reorganization of all part of business of the employer.

All or significant part of the business has been discontinued at a specific location.

All or part of the business has been sold and the succesor employer does not provide a pension plan for the employees acquired.

Such further and other reasons as may come to my attention.

**YOU ARE ENTITLED TO A HEARING** by the Financial Services Tribunal (the “Tribunal”) pursuant to section 89(6) of the *PBA*. **To request a hearing, you must deliver to the Tribunal a written notice that you require a hearing, within thirty (30) days after this Notice of Intended Decision is served on you.**<sup>1</sup>
