## NOTICE OF INTENDED DECISION

I INTEND TO MAKE AN ORDER under section 69 of the *PBA* that the **Employee** Retirement Plan of Doubleday Canada Limited, Registration 0245431 (the "Plan") be wound up effective December 9, 2010.

## I INTEND TO MAKE THE ORDER FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS:

The employer is bankrupt within the meaning of the Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act (Canada).

All or a significant portion of the business carried on by the employer at a specific location was discontinued.

Such further and other reasons as may come to my attention.

YOU ARE ENTITLED TO A HEARING by the Financial Services Tribunal (the "Tribunal") pursuant to section 89(6) of the *PBA*. To request a hearing, you must deliver to the Tribunal a written notice that you require a hearing, within thirty (30) days after this Notice of Intended Decision is served on you.<sup>1</sup>
