NOTICE OF PROPOSAL

I PROPOSE TO MAKE AN ORDER under section 69 of the *PBA* that the **Pension Plan for Whitby Plant Employees for Sklar-Peppler Furniture Corporation**, (the "Plan), be wound up effective **August 13, 2008**, with such wind up to include the class of plan members and former members whose employment or plan membership terminated during the period July 28, 2007 to August 13, 2008.

REASONS:

- 1. There was a cessation or suspension of employer contributions to the pension fund.
- 2. The employer is bankrupt within the meaning of the Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act (Canada).
- 3. A significant number of members of the pension plan ceased to be employed by the employer as a result of the discontinuance of all or part of the business of the employer or as a result of the reorganization of the business of the employer.
- 4. All or a significant portion of the business carried on by the employer at a specific location was discontinued.
- 5. Such further and other reasons as may come to my attention.

YOU ARE ENTITLED TO A HEARING by the Financial Services Tribunal (the "Tribunal) pursuant to section 89(6) of the *PBA*. To request a hearing, you must deliver to the Tribunal a written notice that you require a hearing, within thirty (30) days after this Notice of Proposal is served on you.¹
