NOTICE OF PROPOSAL

I PROPOSE TO MAKE A DECLARATION under section 83 of the *PBA* that the Pension Benefits Guarantee Fund applies to the **Pension Plan for Certain Hourly-Rated Employees at the Toronto, Ontario Factory Service Branch of Trailmobile Parts & Service Canada Ltd., (the "Plan"), Registration Number 297457.**

REASONS:

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- 1. The Plan is registered under the *PBA*; and
- 2. The Plan provides defined benefits that are not exempt from the application of the Pension Benefits Guarantee Fund by the *PBA* or the Regulations made thereunder; and
- 3. The Superintendent has ordered the wind up of the Plan effective March 13, 2009; and
- 4. There are reasonable and probable grounds that the funding requirements of the *PBA* and regulations cannot be satisfied. Based on the latest actuarial certification, there is an estimated claim against the Pension Benefits Guarantee Fund of \$736,000 determined as at March 13, 2009. If funds become available from the estate of the employer, the administrator will be required to make an appropriate refund of any allocation amount received by the Plan from the Pension Benefits Guarantee Fund; and
- 5. Such further and other reasons as may come to my attention.

YOU ARE ENTITLED TO A HEARING by the Financial Services Tribunal (the "Tribunal") pursuant to section 89(6) of the *PBA*. To request a hearing, you must deliver to the Tribunal a written notice that you require a hearing, within thirty (30) days after this Notice of Proposal is served on you.¹

NOTE - Pursuant to section 112 of the *PBA* any Notice, Order or other document is sufficiently given, served or delivered if delivered personally or sent by regular mail and any document sent by regular mail shall be deemed to be given, served or delivered on the seventh day after the date of mailing.
