NOTICE OF PROPOSAL

I PROPOSE TO MAKE AN ORDER under section 78(4) of the *PBA*, consenting to the payment out of the Plan to **Samuel Manu-Tech Inc.**, as at **September 30, 2009** in the amount of \$237,233.00 plus interest to the date of payment.

REASONS:

- 1. **Samuel Manu-Tech Inc.** is the employer as defined in the Plan.
- 2. As a result of the employer funding the deficit on the wind up of the Plan as at May 31, 2007, there are assets remaining after all the benefits have been settled.
- 3. Evidence of the overpayment to the fund has been submitted to the Financial Services Commission of Ontario.
- 4. Such further and other reasons as may come to my attention.

YOU ARE ENTITLED TO A HEARING by the Financial Services Tribunal (the "Tribunal") pursuant to section 89(6) of the PBA. To request a hearing, you must deliver to the Tribunal a written notice that you require a hearing, within thirty (30) days after this Notice of Proposal is served on you.¹
