NOTICE OF PROPOSAL

I PROPOSE TO MAKE AN ORDER under section 69 of the *PBA* that Canadian Health Industry Pension Plan (the "Plan") be wound up effective March 1, 2006.

REASONS:

There was a cessation or suspension of employer contributions to the pension fund.

Such further and other reasons as may come to my attention.

YOU ARE ENTITLED TO A HEARING by the Financial Services Tribunal (the "Tribunal") pursuant to section 89(6) of the *PBA*. To request a hearing, you must deliver to the Tribunal a written notice that you require a hearing, within thirty (30) days after this Notice of Proposal is served on you.¹
