NOTICE OF PROPOSAL

I PROPOSE TO MAKE AN ORDER under section 69 of the *PBA Pension Plan for the Salaried Employees of Daymonex Limited* (the “Plan”) be wound up effective **June 30, 2009**.

The employer is bankrupt within the meaning of the Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act (Canada).

YOU ARE ENTITLED TO A HEARING by the Financial Services Tribunal (the “Tribunal”) pursuant to section 89(6) of the *PBA*. **To request a hearing, you must deliver to the Tribunal a written notice that you require a hearing, within thirty (30) days after this Notice of Proposal is served on you.**¹
