DECLARATION

No request requiring a hearing was delivered to the Financial Services Tribunal within the time prescribed by subsection 89(6) of the *PBA* respecting a Notice of Proposal to make a Declaration that the Pension Benefits Guarantee Fund applies to the **Pension Plan for Salaried Employees** of NRI Manufacturing Inc., Registration Number 980870 (the "Plan").

I DECLARE pursuant to sections 83 and 89 of the *PBA* that the Pension Benefits Guarantee Fund ("Guarantee Fund") applies to the Plan for the following reasons:

- 1. The Plan is registered under the *PBA*, and
- 2. The Plan provides defined benefits that are not exempt from the application of the Pension Benefits Guarantee Fund by the *PBA* or the Regulations made thereunder, and
- 3. The Plan was wound up effective February 16, 2007, and
- 4. There are reasonable and probable grounds that the funding requirements of the *PBA* and regulations cannot be satisfied. Based on the latest actuarial certification, there is an estimated claim against the Guarantee Fund of **\$919,700** as at **January 31, 2009**. If funds become available from the estate of the employer, the administrator will be required to make an appropriate refund of any allocation amount received by the Plan from the Guarantee Fund.
