## NOTICE OF PROPOSAL

I PROPOSE TO MAKE AN ORDER under section 69 of the *PBA* that the **Pension Plan for Non-Bargaining Salaried Employees of Trailmobile Parts & Service Canada Ltd.** (the "Plan"), be wound up effective March 13, 2009.

## **REASONS:**

- 1. The employer is bankrupt within the meaning of the Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act (Canada).
- 2. All or a significant portion of the business carried on by the employer at a specific location has been discontinued.
- 3. Such further and other reasons as may come to my attention.

YOU ARE ENTITLED TO A HEARING by the Financial Services Tribunal (the "Tribunal ) pursuant to section 89(6) of the *PBA*. To request a hearing, you must deliver to the Tribunal a written notice that you require a hearing, within thirty (30) days after this Notice of Proposal is served on you.<sup>1</sup>

## IF YOU FAIL TO REQUEST A HEARING WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS, I MAY CARRY OUT THE PROPOSAL AS DESCRIBED IN THIS NOTICE.
