## **ORDER**

No request requiring a hearing was delivered to the Financial Services Tribunal within the time prescribed by subsection 89(6) of the *PBA* respecting a Notice of Proposal to make an Order to wind up the **Lofthouse Brass Manufacturing Pension Plan for G. Bryant Brown** (the "Plan").

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Plan be wound up in full effective May 27, 2008 for the following reasons:

There was a cessation or suspension of employer contributions to the pension fund.

The employer failed to make contributions to the pension fund as required by the PBA.

The employer is bankrupt within the meaning of the Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act (Canada).

All or a significant portion of the business carried on by the employer at a specific location was discontinued.
