## Hydro One

Hydro One has appealed the August 1, 2007 decision of the Financial Services Tribunal to the Divisional Court. The Tribunal decision directed the Superintendent to order a partial wind up of the Hydro One Pension Plan with respect to all management plan members who ceased to be employed by Hydro One from September 1, 2002 to December 31, 2002.

### ***Updated on September 5, 2007***

The Appeal is scheduled to be heard by the Divisional Court on February 8, 2008.

### ***Updated on January 8, 2008***

On February 8, 2008, the Divisional Court heard the appeal and reserved its decision.

### ***Updated on February 8, 2008***

On March 27, 2008, the Divisional Court dismissed the appeal with costs payable by Hydro One to the management members who were respondents in the appeal.

### ***Updated on April 16, 2008***

On April 9, 2008, Hydro One applied to the Court of Appeal for leave to appeal the Divisional Court's decision.

### ***Updated on June 4, 2008***

On October 9, 2008, the Court of Appeal granted leave to Hydro One to appeal the Divisional Court's decision.

The appeal is scheduled to be heard by the Court of Appeal on May 12, 2009.

The appeal has been adjourned from May 12 to September 8, 2009.
