REASONS FOR INTENDED DECISION

- 1. B&W Heat Treating Canada ULC sponsored the above noted pension plan.
- 2. The pension plan is a defined contribution type and Sun Life Financial was the plan custodian.
- 3. Sun Life Financial was appointed as plan administrator on November 10, 2022
- 4. Pursuant to clause 69(1)c of the Act, the plan sponsor is bankrupt within the meaning of the Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act (Canada) effective March 31, 2020
- 5. Pursuant to clause 69(1)d of the Act, all or substantially all of the members of the pension plan cease to be employed by the employer effective September 30, 2019.
- 6. Such further and other reasons as may come to my attention.
