- Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC) The CMHC is Canada's national housing agency. The CMHC website features useful consumer information on buying a home, mortgage loan insurance, renting, maintaining and renovating a home, plus much more.
- Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) The CRA administers the Home Buyers' Plan – a federal program that allows you to withdraw money from your registered retirement savings plans to buy or build a qualifying home. The agency's website contains questions and answers as well as a helpful guide on this program.
- Canadian Consumer Information Gateway The joint project of several hundred federal departments, provincial and territorial ministries and non-governmental organizations, this website offers a comprehensive collection of solutions to common issues faced by consumers.
